school student about that career field, please contact Mrs. Dukelow at jdukelow@susd.org.

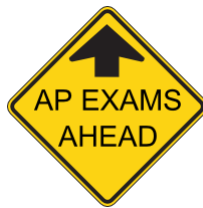

\$94 per exam until November 14th at 2:30 pm. After this time and until March 3rd, there will be a \$50 late fee assessed per exam.

AP US Government is the ONLY exam that can be ordered after November 14th through March 5th without a late fee. This course doesn't begin until January and therefore, the late fee does not apply. Absolutely no AP exams can be ordered after March 5th. There are no exceptions.
