Financial Aid Night at Arcadia High School

Wednesday, November 13, 2019, at 6:00pm, in Mt. Olympus

The 2020-2021 FAFSA (FREE Application for Federal Study Aid) opened on October 1st. Learn how to fill out the FAFSA and discover why it's important. Did you know many students and parents don't fill out the FAFSA because they think federal grants are only available to families earning less than \$50,000? The truth is, you could qualify for other financial assistance despite your income. When some schools have tuition over \$65,000, need-based financial aid is even available to students from middle and upper-middle class income brackets.

In addition, there will be a brief overview of the CSS Profile. The CSS Profile is required by several hundred private schools and a few public universities. The CSS Profile asks for detailed financial information in order to assist in demonstrated need. Be sure to check to see if the school your student is applying to requires the CSS Profile. It takes a bit more time to complete.

The presentation will be given by Financial Aid Officers from University of Oregon & Arizona State University. This is a complimentary service provided by University of Oregon & ASU and is applicable to ALL higher education institutions (in-state and out-of-state). You do NOT need to be attending University of Oregon or ASU to benefit from this informative presentation.

Cap & Gown Orders

Orders were collected during lunch and after school on Monday, 11/04/2019. Some clarifications regarding this date are below:



• <u>This was not the deadline</u>. The deadline to order prior to being assessed a late fee (up to \$8 per cap/gown) assessed by Balfour is 01/17/2020. You can place your order anytime until that day to without being assessed a late fee

- You can order online by <u>visiting the Balfour website</u> directly or ordering in person when the Balfour personnel are present on campus or mailing the order form provided in the packet or going to the Balfour facility (16585 N 92nd St. #105, Scottsdale, AZ 85260).
- <u>Balfour offers more than just cap & gown</u>. Some of these items may not be available after 01/17/2020, so make sure to order prior to the deadline to get the items you want as well as avoid the late fee.
- Online ordering has an up charge of \$12.95. Online ordering does have a convenience fee, however it is \$3.00 not \$12.95. Shipping & Handling fee for online orders is \$12.95 however Shipping & Handling fee for in person order is \$8.95 which is a difference of \$3.00. You can avoid the \$3.00 fee by bringing in orders when Balfour is on campus, mail in the order form or take it to Balfour facility




Varsity Cheer took FIRST out of 20 teams! They qualified for the State Championship Competition along with their victory.
